5th Grade Band

This season the 5th Grade band students from Pioneer and Frontier Elementary Schools will be performing at the Pioneer MS Spring Concert and Pioneer MS Open House. They will be joined by the Pioneer MS 6th Grade Band & Concert Band. For these performances, students will be required to wear dress pants or skirts (skirts must be below the knee, no jeans), dress shoes (please avoid sneakers), long dress socks for men & stockings for women, and a button-up dress shirt for men & modest top or dress for women (no bare shoulders/low necklines). 

Panther Pride Qualifications



3RD 5TH GRADE STUDENTS

PANTHER PRIDE CRITERIA (TRIMESTER GUIDELINES):

- No discipline referrals during current trimester
- MUST HAVE ALL "CONSISTENTLY" MARKS AND/OR NO MORE THAN 2 "MOST OF THE TIME" ON THEIR WORK HABITS ON THE REPORT CARD FOR THE TRIMESTER IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS: Accepts responsibility for own behavior, Follows Directions, Respects other's rights/feelings/property, Uses time effectively, and Completes and returns homework.
- No more than 4 CLIP CHART POINTS (i.e. ending on pink or purple).
- ANY NEW STUDENT MUST HAVE BEEN ENROLLED BY THE **BEGINNING** DATE OF THE PROGRESS REPORTS.
- No more than 2 combined attendance marks during the current trimester in the following categories (excused or unexcused):
 - ABSENCES
 - TARDIES
 - EARLY SIGN-OUTS

<u>Please Note:</u> Students on IEPs will be considered meeting the above criteria for <u>Citizenship</u> if they are making progress towards meeting their individual IEP goals.
